



Broadway property owners can plant certain trees in the public right-of-way for just 25% of the cost. The City of Rock Island offers a 50/50 Tree Program that pays 50% of the cost to have a new tree planted, and the Broadway Historic District will contribute an additional 25% of the cost, up to \$250 per household.

Trees are planted in the fall or spring, depending on the species. The city's tree program has 12 approved species, with Broadway able to help pay for seven species: Sugar Maple, Witch Hazel, Little Leaf Linden, Thornless Honey Locust, Red Maple, Red Oak, and Ginkgo-Biloba. Additional species can be submitted for possible approval.

Broadway's Board of Directors must also approve a request in order for you to receive Broadway funding. Please fill out this form and submit it to Broadway Historic District, Broadway Historic District Association, P.O. Box 5362, Rock Island, IL 61204. The program is subject to availability of funds.

Once you are approved and the work is completed, Broadway will reimburse you 25% of the cost (up to \$250) upon receiving a copy of the city's approval of your application and a receipt of your payment of 50% of the cost to the city. Broadway must receive your receipt within 30 days of payment.
