Broadway Feral Friends-Lindsay

So far in 2015, we have helped 9 cats—6 spay/neuter, 3 shots only

33 were helped in 2014, so our organization has helped more than 40 cats so far. The bulk of the 33 were spay/neuter, which obviously helps cut down our kitten population in the neighborhood.

Marketing-Lindsay and Barb

The website is going well, and is continuing to be fine-tuned. A wine walk page was added for a cost of \$25.

Welcome Bags-Wendy

Welcome bag was delivered to 847 22nd St (Dionna and family). I have several to deliver when the new owners are settled, including Karoyln Williams former home on 23rd. I was told this was purchased by a college professor moving from MN.

Wine Walk

Up to homeowners to prepare or provide for food. Jumers is giving the hotel/dinner package they have given in the past. There is going to be a "lottery ticket basket" up for raffle. American Bank is giving \$100 this year as is US Bank (down from \$500). Gary Rowe is the head fundraiser.

After discussion, the Board determined that hosting homeowners will be given at least \$100 before the event to help cover the cost of food. Javier will make this clear to the committee.
